Glenore Centre - new stores to open

THE major refurbishment and additions to the Glenore Centre in Glenashley that started in February 2008, will be complete in November 2008.

Phase one will be launched as early as early July 2008. This phase consists of the following tenants: The Bangkok Wok, Andrea's Dolce Vita (formerly La Pizza Pazza, new venue, new look), The House of Paint, Blue Taboo Hair and Style Studio.

Jimmy's Killer Prawn's new double story restaurant (including a full sushi

bar) will come on line around mid-August, followed by a trendy FEGO Coffee Shop a month later.

The balance of the centre, including a KwikSpar, Tops Liquor, a DVD store, interior decorating store and a further restaurant, will be trading before the year is out.

The new centre will be unlike anything north of Durban, boasting sea views from all of the restaurants, ample free parking and a children's playground.
